Finance – Equity Funding

Equity funding is given to some services according to the needs of equity, so that every child has access to quality education and care.

There are 4 components our service is receiving equity funding for 2 components: A – low – social and B – special needs.

This year's equity funding will be spent on our children who cannot afford our fees but would like to access our service. This will be in line with Equity of Access and Participation at the Marian Centre.

Last year's amount of EF for Component A - \$6,869.28 and for component B - \$5,932.56 for employing an additional staff support.

EF for 2022 is currently amounting to \$8,124.56 for educational materials to support special need and waving of fees for our children who cannot pay (under 3's)

Social – Emotional Learning:

We will continue developing skills to learn how to: focus attention, listen, be assertive, and use self-talk

We will encourage children to share or retell stories they are familiar with to extend language and communication skills
